## Treatment Information

Thank you for trusting Wolbert's Inc. to address your invading rodent problem. Here are a few things you should know about the process and what to expect for the next several days.

We have inspected and documented rodent evidence and obvious entry points, as well as other conditions conducive to infestation. **Mice can squeeze through any gap larger than ¼ inch**, making thorough exclusion work vital to success. We will plug any small access points in broken vent screens, foundation cracks, small voids around plumbing, and HVAC penetrations, and note larger repairs that require carpentry or masonry/concrete work. We can refer you to a qualified contractor for repairs beyond the scope of our work.

We then set a network of snap traps in areas where rodent traffic is obvious. We will return in one week, and again at two weeks, to check and clean out the traps. At the last visit we will remove the snap traps and place rodent bait stations at strategic locations for the duration of the warranty period.

If any previously documented larger repairs and exclusion work are not completed by our last visit, we will not be able to warranty our work, as rodents will continue to infest.

If your structure is deemed too porous or complex for the satisfactory exclusion of rodents, we will recommend an ongoing trapping/baiting program to manage the populations that have access to your structure. We are unable to extend any warranty to sites where exclusion is not possible.

***Please help us by apprising anyone needing access to your sub-area, or anywhere there are traps set, to either wait until our trapping is complete or be aware of set traps to avoid personal injury.***

Please feel free to call if you see or suspect a rodent has been caught on a trap and we will come out and take care of it, or if you have any questions or concerns.
