## Treatment Information

Thank you for trusting Wolbert's Inc. to address your termite infestation. Here are a few things you should know about your treatment and what to expect in the near future.

Our inspection has revealed that you have active subterranean termites infesting structural wood in your home. Our objective is to treat not only the visible termites, but to apply a barrier zone of a non-repellent, transferrable control product to the soil around and under your home for long lasting protection. This is accomplished by shallow trenching or soil injection around the foundation and around pier posts in the sub-area (if applicable), plus drilling and injecting material under concrete slabs adjacent to wood. We may also treat other structures where wood is contacting the ground, or where decaying tree stumps are near the structure. If you have a basement, we may drill and inject adjacent to wood or where termites are observed entering through cracks or cold joints.

Where concrete drilling is necessary, ½ inch holes will be drilled every 12 to 15 inches, then plugged and patched after injection. We may ask you to move items away from walls prior to sub-slab treatment.

**This treatment takes time to be fully effective as the termite workers move through the treated soil and transfer active molecules back to the rest of the termite colony. This process can take up to 120 days. A termite colony can be several yards wide and 15 feet deep.**

The product used for this treatment binds readily to soil particles and will not leech into ground water.

We will have alerted you to conditions conducive to infestation such as earth-to-wood contact in your sub-area or around the exterior. Leftover concrete form wood or scraps in your sub-area are also attractive to termites. Removal/repair of these conditions is helpful against re-infestation.

We extend a one-year warranty against termite infestation, and control can be expected for many years before treatment is needed again.
