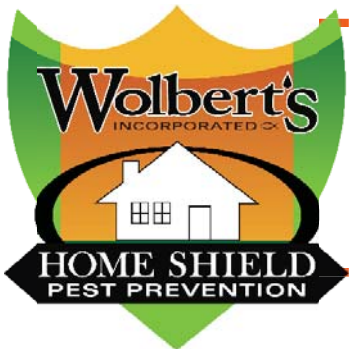
Today's treatment may have left some dead or dying hornets/wasps under a nest on or around your home. We ask that you keep children and pets out of those areas to prevent stings to feet and curious noses. The nest population should be completely controlled within 3 days. We can remove easily accessible leftover nest material. Nests high in eaves will deteriorate over time or can be removed with next pressure washing/painting.

We can provide trapping ideas to help keep your yard safer from yellow jacket swarming during our brief picnic season. We can also help identify and treat trees and plants where yellow jackets congregate to feed on aphids (one of their favorite meals). Controlling the aphid population will greatly reduce an attractive food source.
